

Mac Uninstallation Instructions for Workspace and CPS

For a clean uninstall of Workspace and drivers—drag each of the following to the trash:

- Hard Drive: Applications: eInstruction
- Hard Drive: Applications: Interwrite Learning
- Hard Drive: Library: Application Support: IW Device Manager
- Hard Drive: Library: Preferences - remove anything to do with Interwrite, GTCO and eInstruction
- Hard Drive: Users: Your User Name: Library: Application Support: IW Device Manager
- Hard Drive: Users: Your User Name: Library: Application Support: einstruction : IW Device Manager
- Hard Drive: Users: Your User Name: Library: Preferences - remove anything to do with Interwrite, GTCO and eInstruction

Empty the trash. You can now install the latest version of Workspace, then restart.

For a clean uninstall of CPS, CPS for PPT, and drivers—drag each of the following to the trash:

- HD: Applications: CPS (trash CPS directory)
- HD: System: Library: Extensions: ftdiusbserialdriver.kext
- HD: Library: Application Support: CPS (trash directory)
- HD: Library: Receipts: FTDIUSBSerialDriver.pkg
- HD: Library: Receipts: FTDIUSBSerialDriverI386.pkg
- HD: Library: Receipts: CPS.pkg
- HD: Library: Receipts: VComponents.pkg
- HD: Library: StartupItems: FTDIReEnumerate (trash directory)
- HD: Users: [username]: Library: Preferences: [anything that begins with CPS]

Empty the trash. You can now install the latest version of CPS, then restart.
